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## POST-OPERATIVE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

SOFT TISSUE GRAFTING

#### **BLEEDING**

- **Do not spit, sip through a straw, or rinse mouth** during the first day.
- There may be <u>blood present in your saliva</u> for the first day or two following surgery. This is normal. If bleeding does occur, apply firm pressure with moist gauze or a moist tea bag for **15** minutes. Repeat if necessary.
- Do not be surprised if you experience a little bleeding throughout the night. Put a towel over your pillow prior to going to sleep.

#### **ORAL HYGIENE**

- Avoid vigorous rinsing for 24 hours.
- **Do not brush** the surgical area for one week, or until instructed to do so.
- Brush your remaining teeth, gums and tongue with a new toothbrush, as thoroughly as
  possible, taking precaution to avoid disturbing the site.

## **SWELLING**

- Swelling and bruising will be greatest during the first **24-72** hours following surgery.
- Do not place ice or cold compresses near the surgical site.
- If possible, at night **elevate your head** by using extra pillows.

## **DIET & EXERCISE**

- Do not eat anything (hot or spicy) for approximately 2 hours, or until the numbness is gone. You may eat warm or cold foods.
- Only consume <u>soft foods</u> during the first day or two following surgery, in order to avoid contaminating the wound with food particles.
- Use fork and knife. Avoid eating on the side of your mouth that was operated on.
- Smoking is discouraged for the first two weeks following surgery.
- Alcohol consumption is also discouraged for the first three days.
- **Do not exercise** for **two** days following surgery (aerobic activity).

### **ANALGESICS & ANTIBIOTICS**

- <u>Some discomfort can be expected</u> for the first few days but will gradually subside with healing of the tissue. If you experience any discomfort, take two Tylenol, Advil, etc., or medication we have prescribed at **4-6 hour intervals**, or as prescribed.
- If prescribed, take the antibiotics tablets in accordance with instructions on the bottle.
- If you develop a **fever above 100 degrees**, call the office.
